- Heart rate (bpm)

Disability

- Blood Glucose (mg/dL)
- Exposure
- Temperature (°C)

Medical tests

Request the following medical tests:

Decision aids

- Stroke scale (NIHSS) Imaging
- Cerebral CT angiogram
- Head CT
