Dialogues

Ask the following questions to the patient:

Medical condition

- Can you tell me your name and your age?
- Do you know where you are at the moment?
- What happened to him?
- Does he have any health problems?
- When was the last time you saw him well?

Medication

- Does he take any medication?

Nutrition

- When was the last time that he had something to eat?

Physical examination

Perform the following physical examinations:

Airway

- Airway observation

Breathing

- O₂ Sat (%)
- Respiratory rate (breath/min)

Circulation

- Blood pressure (mmHg)
- Capillary refill time (seconds)
- Heart rate (bpm)

Disability

- Blood glucose (mg/dL)
- Glasgow Coma Scale

Exposure

- Temperature (°C)

Medical tests

Request the following medical tests:

Decision aids

- FAST scale
- FAST-ED scale
- Race scale

Treatments

Administer the following treatments:

Call - Comprehensive Stroke Center

- Call > Comprehensive Stroke Center

Interventions - Oxygen therapy. One of the following:

- Interventions > Oxygen > Nasal cannula
- Interventions > Oxygen > High flow mask
- Interventions > Oxygen > Non-rebreathing mask
